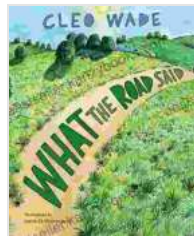

How does analyzing poetry give you better understanding? When you read a poem, you use your knowledge to better comprehend the poem whether you have little knowledge. Always remember that poets use literary techniques in every poem to show or achieve a particular effect.

In *A Thank-You Note* by Michael Ryan, I noticed a story in the poem about a father thanking a friend of his because she sent his daughter pen to write with to show a healing process. Do you know what happened that might have hurt her? No, you don't because the poet has left that with you to understand thoroughly. Michael Ryan had a rhyming pattern in the poem, with words like "card" and "hard," "sent" and "instrument", and "done" and "one" to rhyme. To rhyme is have or end with a sound that corresponds to another. He also had another literary technique known as a simile. My example in his poem was "Who can love you as your child does?" A simile is a figure of speech involving the comparison of one thing with another of a different kind, used to make a description more emphatic or vivid. In this case, he was comparing the love your child gives you than anyone else.

Robert Frost wrote a poem called *Mending Wall*. I noticed that when I read the poem that he used repetition as a literary technique. He would always repeat "Good fences make good neighbors." When you use repetition, it is usually used to emphasize on something, but when I read that line the first time, the only word that came to mind was alone or

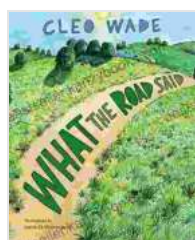

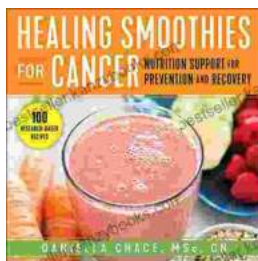
