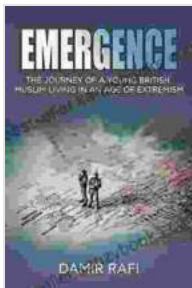

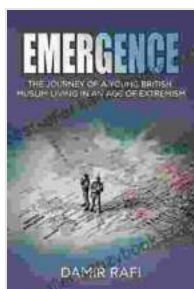
Yasin El-Qady is a British Muslim author, speaker, and activist. He is the founder and director of the Cordoba Foundation, a non-profit organization

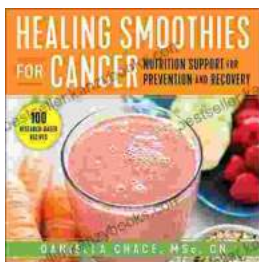

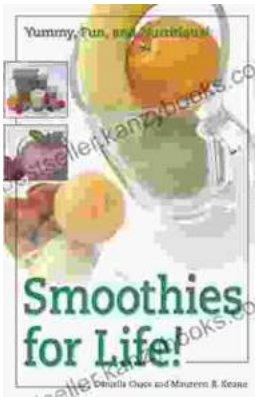
